



Transformation, Strategic Planning and Governance

The Levine Act

California Government Code § 84308



Previous Rules

- Political Reform Act Generally, campaign contributions are not considered a source of income that gives rise to a conflict of interest with certain exceptions.
- Levine Act (Original Legislation) limited to apply only to "appointed" members of legislative bodies – not elected officials.
- Applied to proceedings for licenses, permits, entitlements and contracts.
 Aimed at construction/development projects, but can apply to hospital contracts with vendors.



Levine Act Amendment (SB 1439)

- The Levine Act applies to both appointed and elected boards, including SVH Board and Committees
- While a proceeding is pending, and for 12 months following decision, a Board/Committee members <u>must not</u>:
 - Accept, solicit, or direct a contribution of more than \$250.00 from a party, a party's agent, or participant (or participant's agent)
 - Applies to contributions to the Board/Committee member and contributions to <u>others directed by the</u>
 Board/Committee member
 - For contributions following the final decision, the Board/Committee member can cure the violation if contribution is returned within 14 days if certain conditions are met



Levine Act – Disclosure and Participation

- <u>Disclosure</u> Board/Committee Member must disclose on the record during action item of contributions of more than \$250.00 for a party or a participant, or their agents
- Participation Board/Committee Member must not participate in the action item if the Board/Committee member has willfully or knowingly received a contribution of more than \$250.00 from a party, party's agent, or participant or participant's agent (if Board/Committee member knows the participant has a financial interest) within the past 12 months.
 - Does not apply if contribution is returned within 30 days of receipt.

Levine Act – Agents and Parties

- <u>Agent</u> A person is an agent of a party to, a participant in, or a pending proceeding involving a license, permit or other <u>contract</u> if:
 - Person represents that party or participant for compensation (attorneys, consultants, architects, etc.); AND
 - Appears before or otherwise communicates with governmental agency for the purpose of influencing the decision
- <u>Party</u> the Party must disclose to Board/Committee if they have made a contribution to a member of more than \$250.00 within the prior 12 months. Also cannot make any further contributions during pendency of matter and for 12 months thereafter.



Application to Health Care District

- Applies to both Board Action and Committee Recommendations by Appointed and Elected Officials
- <u>Contracts</u> Most applicable to parties supplying goods and services to the District, including
 architects, attorneys, contractors, etc., that will have contracts up for approval before the
 Committee and Board.
 - **Exceptions** All contracts that are competitively bid, labor or personal employment contracts. RFPs are not considered competitively bid.
- Contributions by Physicians
 - <u>Will not apply</u> to physician recruitment agreements (deemed personal employment contracts), and <u>will not apply</u> to decisions regarding privileges to practice medicine at SVH (governed by Medical Executive Committee).
 - Could apply if physician appeals decision from MEC to the Board. Rare Circumstance.
